On a team with her LPHS colleagues, Alan Dabdoub, Josh Sandler, and Josh Lang, Daniela successfully tried a contract dispute in a 100% virtual trial via Zoom, achieving a \$12.6 million verdict in her clients' favor. In May 2022, Jason Dennis, Greg Brassfield and Daniela also secured a unanimous jury verdict in favor of her clients in the Oldenburg case, further demonstrating her skill in high-stakes litigation.

Daniela started her career working as a litigation associate for an AmLaw 100 firm in Chicago where she represented Fortune 500 companies in labor and employment litigation, including trade secret theft, federal and state discrimination claims and wage claims. In addition to working in state and federal courts, Daniela has represented clients before labor arbitrators, and government administrative agencies.
